The Graduate Division invites nominations and applications for an Associate Dean Position, effective Summer 2007. Applicants and nominees must currently hold tenured UCLA faculty positions. The Associate Dean serves a renewable five -year term at 50% time appointment, with summer differential and stipend.

The Associate Deans are an integral part of the Division's leadership responsible for oversight and administration of graduate education at UCLA, working closely with the Vice Chancellor/Dean, Assistant Vice Chancellor and Graduate Division Assistant Deans, Directors and staff. The Associate Deans assume primary responsibility for policy interpretation, policy exceptions and dispute resolution in matters of graduate student welfare and graduate academic affairs.

A major responsibility of this Associate Dean position will be the development of professional programs directed at supporting UCLA's Postdoctoral Fellows. Experience in this area would be especially valuable. The ability to work collegially on complex issues and be an effective spokesperson and advocate for graduate education issues is particularly important.
