

**MAXIMUM EMPLOYMENT DURING MONTHS THAT INCLUDE  
INTER-QUARTER AND SUMMER PERIODS 2009-2010**

The table below is based on academic quarters. It indicates the number of hours of time factors that may be reported during those months that include inter-quarter or off-quarter periods, without exceeding the permissible total employment computed at 50 percent for academic quarter service and 100 percent for inter-quarter or summer service.
